The U.S. Government Accountability Office has proposed a revision to Government Auditing Standards (the "yellow book") which will effect substantial changes in who may conduct audits under GAO standards and how those audits will be conducted.

### TESTING COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND REGULATIONS IN A GOVERNMENTAL AUDIT

AICPA Standards require that auditors obtain reasonable assurance about material misstatements as a result of noncompliance with laws and regulations that have a direct and material effect on the financial statements.
