We'll also introduce you to the iLife '09 software suite including iTunes, iPhoto, iMovie, iWeb, iDVD, and Garageband. We will give you a preview of iWork '09 as well, comparing features of iWork with MS Office applications like Word. And, if you are switching from PC to Mac, we'll show you how easy and fun that switch to Mac is, and how common Windows applications like Microsoft Excel and Word work effortlessly on the Macintosh platform.
